1. Whether the Reporters of local newspaper may be allowed to see the judgment ?
2. To be referred to the Reporter or not.

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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Today, in pursuance to the directions passed by this Court on 18.3.2016, Ms. Ritu Rani (detenue) has been produced before this Court. She was allowed to interact with the petitioner in Court room itself as she had admitted that she was married with the petitioner. After sometime, her statement has been recorded. She has stated that she was married with the petitioner on 8.7.2015. She has also stated that she alongwith the petitioner had filed a protection petition before this Court. She further stated that on

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23.12.2015, she had voluntarily accompanied her parents as her mother was ill. She further stated that she was not threatened by anybody nor she was illegally detained. Now, she wants to accompany her husband Manmohan Singh (petitioner). Accordingly, she is allowed to accompany her husband Manmohan Singh (present petitioner).

Since the father, aunt and maternal uncle of the detinue are also present in Court, therefore, it is necessary to provide police protection to the petitioner and the detinue. Therefore, it is directed to the Lalru police, on whose behalf Mr. ASI Harpal Singh is present in Court, to accompany the petitioner and detinue to their residence and thereafter, inform the local police, so that the local police may assess the threat perception and if required, provide necessary security to them.

In view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of.
