Prayer made in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing the detenues, namely, Mani, Vikram @ Vicky and Lalli from the illegal custody of respondent No.3 Further, a prayer has also been made to appoint a Warrant Officer to search the above-mentioned detenues.

Reply on behalf of respondent No.3, by way of affidavit of Ramandeep Singh, PPS, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Tarn Taran, Distt. Tarn Taran has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State, while referring para No.3 of the reply, submits that FIR No.36 dated 25.02.2016, under Sections 454 and 380 IPC, at Police Station City Tarn Taran, was

registered at the behest of Daljinder Kaur wife of Gurvinder Singh Jat. In the said FIR, the alleged detainee-Mani was arrested on 18.03.2016. He further submits that so far as the alleged detainees, namely, Vikram @ Vicky and Lalli are concerned, they were not wanted in any case by the police and they have appeared in the police station with the Warrant Officer on 12.03.2016.

In view of the categorical stand taken in reply that the alleged detainee-Mani is an accused in the aforesaid FIR and alleged detainees, namely, Vikram @ Vicky and Lalli, have appeared in the police station with the Warrant Officer, no further orders are required to be passed in the instant petition and the same is disposed of as such.
