The present petition was registered on the basis of complaint/representation made by Sandeep Singh son of Pritam Singh, resident of Vill. Kasel, P.S. Sarai Amanat Khan, Tehsil and District Tarn Taran, wherein it has been alleged that the sister of the complainant-petitioner namely Pardeep Kaur is in illegal custody of Satnam Singh.

Reply by way of affidavit of Jasbir Singh, PPS, D.S.P., Sub Division Tarn Taran has already been filed. Along with the reply, application dated 17.11.2015 (Annexure R-1/T) made by the alleged detainee Pardeep Kaur, which is addressed to S.S.P., Tarn Taran, has also

been annexed, wherein she has stated that her brother (petitioner-complainant) has got a false case under Section 376 IPC registered against Satnam Singh, Army man. Her brother used to create pressure on her in order to extract money from Satnam Singh, Army man. She has further stated that she herself has gone from home due to the fear of her brothers.

In view of the reply so furnished and the fact that the alleged detainee namely Pardeep Kaur has got a complaint registered against the petitioner-complainant Sandeep Singh, the present petition is wholly misconceived and the same is dismissed, as such.
