A perusal of the criminal writ petition shows that according to petitioner herself, who is grandmother of the detenue Gagandeep Kaur married with respondent No.4 with the help of respondent Nos.5 and 6, who happen to be parents of respondent No.4. It is claimed that detenue Gagandeep Kaur was minor at time of marriage and she is in the custody of respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Since, detenue Gagandeep Kaur married with respondent No.4, even if she was minor at that time, her marriage is voidable or not is at her option, therefore, the present petition cannot be called the case of illegal detention.

Accordingly, the present criminal writ petition stands dismissed.
