Prayer made in the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* and for appointment of a Warrant Officer, with a roving writ to search the detenues mentioned in para 3 of the petition.

At this stage, Mr.Anil Kumar Garg, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents no. 4 to 7 and filed his Power of Attorney in Court today, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State has filed reply by way of affidavit of Ravi Bhagat, Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2, along with the report of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Ludhiana (East). The same are taken on record.

As per the said report, the brick kiln site was searched, but nobody was found bounded by the brick kiln owner.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
