Prayer in this petition is for issuance of roving writ in the nature of habeas corpus for the search/release of alleged detainee Kaveri, who is wife of the petitioner and is in illegal and unlawful custody of respondents No.4 to 8.

Mr. Sunil Agnihotri, Advocate puts in appearance and filed Vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5, which is taken on record.

The alleged detainee, namely, Kaveri is present in the Court and

she is duly identified by Mr. Sunil Agnihotri, Advocate. She has made a categorical statement of even date before this Court, recorded separately to the effect that she is not under illegal detention of her parents i.e. respondents No.4 and 5 and, rather, happily staying with them.

In view of the aforesaid categorical statement of Kaveri, the present petition no more survives and is dismissed as such.
