DAYA CHAUDHARY, J. (ORAL)

Learned State counsel, on the basis of affidavit filed by Deputy Controller (Local Audit), Punjab School Education Board, Mohali, submits that the case of the petitioner has been reconsidered and after re-examining the same in the light of relevant instructions, he has been granted the benefit of four years' ACP on completion of his four years in service on 20.08.2012 vide order dated 15.09.2016 and the said order has also been annexed with the affidavit as Annexure R-1, whereas, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the pay of the petitioner has not been re-fixed so far.

Keeping in view the stand taken in the affidavit in para No.4, the benefit of four years ACP has been granted on completion of four years of service and the petitioner is also held entitled for the consequential benefits including re-fixation of pay, the present petition is disposed of with

a direction to the respondents to do the needful within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, in case, the petitioner is still aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to move representation.
