Prayer made in the petition is for grant of parole to the petitioner for a period of eight weeks so as to enable him to construct his house, which had fallen and is presently being reconstructed.

On perusal of the order dated 26.3.2016 (Annexure P-5) passed by the Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur, it is made out that the petitioner had remained on parole from 23.2.2016 to 23.3.2016 and, therefore, he would not be eligible for his next parole before 23.6.2016.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on going through the impugned order (Annexure P-5), this Court is of the considered view that the petitioner does not deserve to be granted the concession of parole, at this stage. However, it would be open to the petitioner to apply for parole afresh before the concerned authorities on or after 23.6.2016.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
