Mr. Ashish Sanghi, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 9 and Mr. Amardeep Singh Gill, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Report of the warrant officer has been received. As per report of the warrant officer, detinue Farhan Alam Siddiqui was found illegally detained with chain and a lock was also fixed around his neck. Some injuries were also found on his person and he was shifted to Civil Hospital, Jalandhar, where he was medico legally examined. The warrant officer was accompanied by ASI Major Singh, In charge, Police Post, Bus Stand.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from H.C. Sushil Kumar, has informed the Court that on the basis of said incident, FIR No.63, dated 06.04.2016 has already been registered at Police Station Division No.7, Jalandhar and the matter is being investigated.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 to 8 seeks time to file reply to explain away the circumstances and to claim that it is all cooked up story of illegal detention.

Since, the FIR has been registered and the matter is under investigation, this Court will refrain from making any comment upon the merits of the case and will leave respondent Nos.4 to 8 to explain away the circumstances during investigation.

The present habeas corpus petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
