HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

On the basis of complaint submitted by petitioner Puran Singh son of Kala Singh, present criminal writ petition was registered. The allegation in the complaint made by the petitioner is that his sons, namely, Jagmeet Singh and Baljeet Singh have been taken by the police of CIA Staff, Ferozepur and they have not committed any offence. He apprehends false implication of his sons.

On notice of motion having been issued, status-report by way of

affidavit of Sulakhan Singh, PPS, DSP (Investigation), Ferozepur has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

The status-report submitted on behalf of the State suggests that the aforesaid persons, namely, Jagmeet Singh and Baljeet Singh were never picked up by the police, rather, they have a long criminal history. As many as six FIRs, either under the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 or regarding fake currency notes, have been registered against them. Earlier also, the wife of petitioner Puran Singh had filed similar petition bearing CRWP No.680 of 2015, which was disposed of by this Court vide order dated 23.7.2015.

Taking into consideration the fact that there are many criminal cases pending against Jagmeet Singh and Baljeet Singh, this Court does not find any merit in the present petition and the same is, accordingly, dismissed.
