Prayer in this petition filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for release of the detenues, as mentioned in para no.2 of this petition, who are stated to be in illegal custody of the private respondents no.4 and 5.

On notice of motion having been issued, learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Kamal Kishor Yadav, IAS, Deputy Commissioner–cum-District Magistrate, Jalandhar as well as status report by way of affidavit of Mukesh Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police Cantonment, Jalandhar, which are taken on record.

Learned State counsel has submitted that none of the alleged detenues was found in illegal custody of respondents no.4 and 5.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

Even counsel for the petitioner has failed to furnish the latest correct addresses of respondents no.4 and 5.

In view of the written statement so furnished by the State, no further order is called for.

The petition is dismissed.
