Learned State counsel has placed on record report dated 24.04.2016 of Police Station City Jagadhri (Haryana) based on the statements of respectables along with the marriage invitation card, whereby it has been adequately reflected that marriage of Raman son of Raghbir Saini, resident of 259, Kalyan Nagar, Jagadhri is to be solemnized on 28.04.2016 with Monika daughter of Amar Nath Saini, resident of Deo Band, Meerut (UP). It is further reported by the police that the petitioner Amar Singh happens to be the real maternal uncle of the boy and therefore, as per the prevalent customs and rituals his presence at the time of marriage is very much essential.

In view of these circumstances, it would sub-serve the ends of justice if the petitioner is granted parole for a period of three

days with effect from 26.04.2016 to 28.04.2016 subject to furnishing of personal bonds for an amount of ₹2.00 lacs with two sureties each of the like amount to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar and the petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar on 29.04.2016 at 10.00 a.m.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
