SURYA KANT, J.

The petitioner's land has been acquired by the National Highway Authority of India for the widening of National Highway No.8. Earlier this land was acquired by the State of Haryana also but that acquisition was challenged by the petitioner and while the matter was still subjudiced before this Court, the NHAI initiated the process of acquisition which has since been finalized.

Learned counsel for the NHAI states that the compensation amount qua structure has already been paid to the petitioner and as regard the land, the payment shall be

paid, if he gives an undertaking that there is no title dispute and that he has not received any compensation from the State Government.

Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees that the petitioner would give such an undertaking to the prescribed authority.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a direction to the respondents that as soon as the petitioner furnishes the requisite undertaking, let the due amount of compensation for the acquired land be released in his favour within one month from the date of such undertaking.
