FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

In compliance of previous order, Mr. Pritpal Singh, Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Station House Officer, Police Station, Dharamgarh, District Sangrur, Station House Officer, Police Station Baretta, District Mansa have come present. Learned State counsel states that due to some miscommunication the orders of this Court could not be served to them. In view of which they are discharged.

Lakhvir Kaur alleged detenue who has been identified by her counsel Yugraj Singh, Advocate as well as by the petitioner-Kuldeep Singh himself and who further has been identified by his counsel, has come present along with a male whom she claims to be her husband and states that they have solemnized marriage and the girl has shown her willingness to live with her said husband.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the

petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the direction to the official respondents to ensure that the couple is escorted safely out of Court premises and are free to go where they want to live.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed not to intimidate thereafter the life and personal liberty of the couple.
