This petition has been entered on the basis of a letter received from Jagir Singh, father of alleged detainee namely, Jaspal Singh.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Satpal Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police (Investigation), Tarn Taran. He has referred to para 2 of the said affidavit. Same reads as under:-

“2. That the police of CIA Staff Tarn Taran has not taken away Jaspal Singh son of the petitioner on 12.04.2016 at about 7.00 a.m. neither he was detained in any case, nor he is wanted in any case by the police of CIA Staff Tarn Taran. However, the statement of petitioner Jagir Singh s/o Charan Singh has been got recorded by the police wherein he has clearly stated that on 12.04.2016 due to fear of missing of his son Jaspal Singh as well as due to fear of his false implication in some false criminal cases by the police, the petitioner moved an application to the Hon'ble High Court, but at the evening of next day i.e. 13.04.2016 Jaspal Singh son of the petitioner came back to his house and neither the police arrested his son Jaspal Singh nor did lodge any false F.I.R. against him. Now Jaspal Singh son of

the petitioner is living in the house. Hence now the petitioner does not want to take any action against anyone. Therefore, the present petition of the petitioner deserve to be dismissed. True translation of statement of Jagir Singh s/o Charan Singh petitioner is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1/T and duly sworn and attested affidavit of Jagir Singh petitioner is annexed herewith as Annexure R-2.”

On instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh (who is present in court), he submits that the alleged detainee is now residing at his home alongwith his family. There is no threat to his life and he is not wanted in any case.

In view of above, present petition has been rendered infructuous. Dismissed as such.
