AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Prayer in CM No.1127 of 2016 is for disposal of the writ petition by directing the respondents to consider and grant the petitioner extension in service till the age of 60 years, in terms of the recent order dated 30.12.2015 (Annexure A-1), passed by the respondents.

Counsel for the applicant-petitioner states that the main writ petition is listed for hearing on 18.07.2016, wherein, the respondents have yet to put in appearance. He further prays that the hearing of the main writ petition be preponed and the same be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation to grant him the benefit of extension in service by two years on he having attained the age of 58 years in the light of the

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order dated 30.12.2015 (Annexure A-1) passed by the Education Secretary, Chandigarh Administration-respondent No.2. He states that the said representation will be filed within a period of one week from today, which may be directed to be considered and decided by respondent No.2 within some specified time.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner, the hearing of the main writ petition is preponed from 18.07.2016 and the same is taken on board for final disposal. The submissions as made by the counsel for the applicant-petitioner are accepted. The application and the writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed representation within a period of one week from today, which shall be considered and decided by Education Secretary, Chandigarh Administration-respondent No.2, within a period of four weeks of submission of such representation. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Copy of the order be given *dasti* to the counsel for the petitioner under signatures of the Bench Secretary of this Court.
