According to learned counsel for the petitioner, minor son of the petitioner was taken away by respondent No.5, who happens to be her husband, for which FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that now the child is being kept by the sister of her husband at different village.

The petitioner had also moved before the SDM for appropriate search proceedings under Section 97 Cr.P.C. and the SDM issued directions to the S.H.O. to search the minor and produce him in the Court with such warrant. It is claimed that the S.H.O. is not obeying the orders.

I am of the view that it is not a case of illegal detention. The petitioner can file a petition for the custody of minor before the Guardian Judge, who is competent to pass the order.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
