JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

This is a petition preferred under Article 226 of Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to release or produce the detenue detailed in para No.3 of the petition who are alleged to be in illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation dated April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.2 as well as to respondent No.3 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation.

3. In fact, respondent No.2-District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra (Haryana) is competent to take an action in case of any person being illegally detained by the owners of brick kiln, as it has been

submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though a representation dated April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved to respondent No.2, but no action has been taken so far.

4. The present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- District Magistrate-cum-Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation April 22, 2016 (Annexure P-1) within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case any detenue is found to be in illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5, they be released forthwith.
