JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

Instant petition has been preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. by Gaurav Modgill seeking directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to get release the detenue namely Simranjeet Kaur from the illegal detention of respondents No.5 and 6.

2. It has been *inter-alia* contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner and detenue are major and have solemnized marriage on March 23, 2016 but when they approached the police, respondent No.3 illegally sent the detenue with her parents i.e. respondents No.5 and 6, without her consent. Even, representation (Annexure P-4) was also moved to respondent No.2 on April 20, 2016 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only, at this stage.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Sidakmeet Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-4) and in case the detenue namely Simranjeet Kaur found to be in illegal detention of respondents No.5 and 6, to get her release and to take other appropriate actions in accordance with law immediately, on receipt of certified copy of this order.
