The perusal of habeas corpus petition shows that as per the petitioner himself, detenue Paramjeet Kaur and respondent No. 4-Harnek Singh had approached this Court for protection of their life and liberty by way of filing CRM-M-12275-2016, which was granted by this Court, vide order dated 8.4.2016. The copy of the said order shows that it was claimed by Paramjeet Kaur and respondent No. 4-Harnek Singh that they have married against the wishes of the parents.

It being so, it cannot be said that Paramjeet Kaur has been illegally detained. Therefore, the present habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
