Petitioner has preferred the instant writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Section 3 (1)(a) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 with a prayer to extend the parole leave of the petitioner for four weeks more as he is already on two weeks parole leave i.e. 27.04.2016 to 12.05.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner Surender alias Titu will surrender before the Superintendent, District Jail, Narnaul.
