In pursuance to the directions of this Court, Garima detenue has been produced before this Court. She was questioned by this Court about her alleged marriage on 11.2.2016 at New Delhi. She has stated that she was intoxicated and she does not know anything about marriage. She also denies that any marriage took place in her full senses as alleged. She has further stated that now she is living with her parents of her free will.

Without commenting anything on the controversy, since detenue states that she is living with her parents of her free will, therefore, it is not a case of illegal detention. Hence, the present habeas corpus petition is dismissed.
