RITU BAHRI, J

The petitioners are seeking writ of certiorari for quashing the termination orders dated 16.5.2014 (Annexures P-3, P-3/A and P-3/B) issued by the respondents, whereby the services of the petitioners have been terminated on the ground that petitioners are not qualified in two years course of electrical/wireman trade from an ITI recognized by State Government.

The petitioners were engaged on the post of Assistant Lineman on DC rate in the year 2008. The petitioners were issued show cause notices (Annexures P-1, P-1/A & P-1/B) stating that at the time of engagement on the post of ALM they have submitted

competency certificate as electrical wireman in respect of examination conducted as ITI Sirsa (Haryana) organized by Construction Industry Development Council, New Delhi. This is further alleged by the respondents that vide Memo no.598 dated 11.3.2014 of Director, ITI Haryana, it has been intimated that said certificate is not equivalent to ITI certificate of two years course. The petitioners filed replies to the show cause notices within the stipulated period on 6.5.2014. (Annexures P-2, P-2/A and P-2/B). Thereafter the services of the petitioners were terminated vide termination letters dated 16.5.2014 (Annexures P-3, P-3/A and P-3/B).

The issue involved in this petition is squarely covered in the **CWP No. 4665 of 2014** (Satish Kumar vs. UHBVN and others) decided by this Court on **18.1.2016**. This petition is also dismissed in terms of that petition.
