This petition emanates from suo *motu* cognizance taken on a representation/complaint sent by petitioner-Major Singh son of Sardul Singh, resident of Ganga Singh Nagar, Jandiala Road, Tarn Taran. The petitioner in his complaint has stated that the police has arrested Baljit Kaur wife of Balbir Singh and Ganga Singh son of Balbir Singh, who are sister-in-law and nephew of the petitioner-complainant from their house on 04.05.2015.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Devinder Singh Sandhu, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Patti, District Tarn Taran, in the Court today, which is taken on record. He on instructions from S.I. Kabal Singh while referring to para No.4 of the reply states that Baljit Kaur wife of Balbir Singh (sister-in-law) and Ganga Singh son of Balbir Singh nephew of the petitioner were neither arrested nor detained, apprehended or picked up by Inspector/SHO

He submits that on 04.05.2015, when the present application was moved by the petitioner, Inspector Gurwinder Singh was not posted as SHO Sarhali. He further submits FIR No.74 dated 25.05.2015 under Section 174A IPC was registered at Police Station Sarhali against Balbir Singh, brother of petitioner and others and in order to create defence in favour of his brother Balbir Singh, petitioner has filed the present application.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly dismissed.
