HARI PAL VERMA, J.

On the basis of representation dated 6.5.2016 made by the petitioner – Rajwant Kaur, which is addressed to Hon’ble the then Acting Chief Justice, the same has been treated as Criminal Writ Petition.

It has been averred that Amjad Khan son of Khushi Mohammed has been illegally detained by the officials of CIA Staff, Moga.

On notice of motion having been issued, reply by way of affidavit of Harinder Singh, PPS, D.S.P. (City), Moga, District Moga, has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State, which is taken on record.

Para No.1 of the preliminary submissions of the said reply reads as under:-

“1. That petitioner has no cause of action to invoke extraordinary jurisdiction of the Hon’ble High Court. Actual

facts are that son of petitioner namely Ajmad Khan @ Deepu son of Khushi Mohammad resident of Ward No.6, Kartar Nagar, Moga, District Moga is neither required by the police of District Moga nor he was ever called by the police of CIA Staff, Moga nor he was ever detained by the officials of CIA Staff, Moga, as alleged by petitioner in present petition.”

On the strength of aforesaid reply, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ram Lubhaya, states that said Ajmad Khan @ Deepu was neither required by the police nor he was ever arrested by the CIA Staff, Moga.

In this view of the matter, no action is called for in the present petition.
