None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was position on 05.05.2016 and 23.05.2016.

Affidavit of Shri P.K. Das, Additional Chief Secretary to Government Haryana, School Education Department had been filed on the last date, in compliance of the order dated 27.02.2016. In the said affidavit it has been deposed that total 22324 number of students have been granted admission in class 2nd to 12th by the private recognized schools under Rule 134-A for the academic session 2015-2016. Some schools had disregarded to comply with the said rule and have not offered admission to the students shortlisted by the Department. Regarding Bhiwani 2331 number of students belonging to EWS/BPL categories have been granted admission under Rule 134-A from class 2nd to 12th in the academic session 2015-2016 and the rule stands substantially implemented. The relevant table showing breakup of

the number of applications received and number of the students admitted have also been given. It has been further averred that for the current academic session 2016-2017, the schedule has already been issued to all the District Education Officers/District Elementary Education Officers vide order dated 10.03.2016 and 14.03.2016. The same was, thereafter, amended vide letter dated 24.04.2016 and 26.04.2016.

Keeping in view the above, it is apparent that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous, as the prayer sought was for taking necessary action against respondents No.4 to 6.

As none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner for the last three dates, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, in view of the stand taken by respondents No.1 to 3 in Para No.5 of the affidavit dated 24.08.2015.
