The application sent by applicant Gurdeep Singh to the office of Hon'ble Chief Justice is treated as criminal writ petition and is taken up on judicial side.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and he was directed to get the matter inquired and produced the detenue Swarna before this Court on the next date of hearing i.e. today.

Today, detenue Swarna Rani has been produced by the police, before this Court. The father of the detenue is also present before this Court. Detnue Swarna Rani has stated that she is 21 years old and she is residing with her parents at her own will and she has not been illegally detained or confined against her wishes. She has further stated that she has no relation with petitioner Gurdeep Singh and one Jasbir Kaur.

Keeping in view the statement of detenue Swarna Rani, she is allowed to go to her parents' house.

In view of above, no further action is required in the instant petition. Therefore, the instant petition stands disposed of.
