The instant petition was registered on the basis of complaint/representation submitted by petitioner-Raju son of Jagtar Singh resident of Village Mari Megha, Tehsil Patti, District Tarn Taran.

In the complaint/representation submitted by the petitioner, it has been pleaded that his wife-Roshni used to make call to accused-Bhola secretly and she was caught by the petitioner many times while making call to said Bhola.

A reply on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab by way of affidavit Doctor Richa Agnihotri, PPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police, East, Amristar along with Annexure R-1/T (True Translation of enquiry report) has been filed in Court today which are taken on record.

Reply reveals that on the basis of complaint/representation so submitted, the matter was enquired into and during the enquiry conducted upon the said complaint, the petitioner and one Aarti wife of Mithun (sister-in-law) of the petitioner were joined and their statements were recorded. On the basis of enquiry, it has revealed that Roshni wife

of the petitioner had come to her parental home on 09.05.2016 for meeting her parents. Thereafter, on 12.05.2016, mother and sister-in-law of Roshni had made her sit in the bus of Bhikwind at Bus Stand Amritsar for going to her matrimonial house at Village Maari Megha, Distt. Tarn Taran, but she did not reach her matrimonial home and since then she has gone somewhere allegedly with said Bhola resident of Village Maari Megha. In this manner, no involvement of her family members has been found. It has been stated by the in-laws of the petitioner that the matter was reported to the local police station Khalra, Distt. Tarn Taran and the petitioner has been directed to follow up this matter at Women Cell, Goindwal Sahib, Tarn Taran and the application No.1544-COP dated 19.05.2016 has been recommended to be consigned to office.

In view of the reply so furnished which shows that the wife of the petitioner has gone somewhere at her own will, present petition is dismissed.
