Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation/ reminder dated 5.4.2016 (Annexure P-2), wherein the petitioner has claimed premature release on completion of his sentence.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that for seeking premature release, the petitioner has already moved the representation dated 5.4.2016 (Annexure P-2) but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, Deputy A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of copies of paper book to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 5.4.2016 (Annexure P-2) for grant of premature release of the petitioner in accordance with law, within a period of four months from today.
