Reply on behalf of respondent-State has already been filed. It is contended by the learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Tejinder Singh, Incharge Narcotic Cell, that Harjinder Singh son of Ravail Singh father of the applicant and Judgebir Singh brother of the applicant were never called in the Police Station nor they are required in any criminal case pertaining to Narcotic Cell, Amritsar and that Gurjant Singh son of Harjinder Singh, brother of the petitioner, who was found trafficking narcotics was apprehended by the Police on 18.05.2016 and 100 grams of heroin was recovered from his possession regarding which FIR No.17 dated 18.05.2016 under Section 21 of the NDPS Act has been registered with Police Station, Srai Amant Khan, District Tarn Taran and, thereafter, was produced before the Court and since then he is in judicial custody.

Since a legal recourse has been adopted qua him and there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner impels this Court to dismiss the present petition.
