RITU BAHRI, J.

The petitioner is seeking benefit of stepping up of pay at par with his juniors, who belong to reserve category in view of the instructions dated 27.11.2006 and 05.03.2009 (Annexures P-1 & P-2).

The Government of Haryana issued instructions dated 27.11.2006 (Annexure P-1), whereby it was notified that since some General Category employees have been demanding fixation of pay at par with their juniors, the Government has decided that no arrears of salary was payable to the employee for the period between the deemed date of promotion and the actual date of promotion. These instructions have been issued in view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *State of Haryana and others Vs. O.P. Gupta*, 1996 (2) RSJ 194.

The petitioner made a representation claiming benefit pursuant to the aforesaid instructions, but no action has been taken thereon till date.

Thereafter, he sent a legal notice dated 02.07.2010 (Annexure P-4) to the

respondents.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by giving a direction to the respondents to look into the legal notice dated 02.07.2010 (Annexure P-4) and pass an appropriate order in accordance with law, within a period of three months.
