Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2 to grant extension of 4 weeks parole to the petitioner w.e.f. 12.6.2016 i.e. the date on which he is due to surrender before the jail authority.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the extension is sought on the ground that son of the petitioner, namely, Karan Sandhu is required to undergo brain surgery.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the certificate dated 25.5.2016 (Annexure P-2) issued by Khosla Hospital, Patiala Road, near New Bus Stand, Bhawanigarh (Sangrur).

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon the genuineness of certificate (Annexure P-2), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. Superintendent, District Jail, Sangrur to decide the case of the petitioner seeking extension of parole before the date fixed for his surrender i.e. 12.6.2016 in accordance with law.
