The present petition was filed by the petitioner-Amrik Singh by making a complaint addressed to the Registry of this Court, which was registered as instant criminal writ petition pursuant to the orders made by Hon'ble the Chief Justice. This court appointed amicus curiae to present the case on behalf of the petitioner.

Now there is status report submitted by Sameer Verma, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division City, Hoshiarpur coupled with statement R-1/T of the petitioner that his son aged about 27 years has gone for some work and had sent this complaint/letter to the Registry of this Court in wrong impression.

Learned counsel for the petitioner-Amrik Singh, other than Amicus Curiae, states that the son of the petitioner was in the same city perhaps gone for some work somewhere. He further submits that the

petitioner should be excused as he is a driver and did not understand the law.

In my opinion, the petitioner has taken the entire machinery for a ride for no reasons and without any justification as not finding out his son whose age is 27 years. Entire process was set in motion, therefore, the petitioner Amrik Singh is directed to deposit a sum of ₹10,000/- as costs to the State of Punjab within a period of ten weeks from today.

Upon failure to pay the costs by the petitioner-Amrik Singh he shall be sent to civil prison for one month.

In view of the fact that the son of the petitioner has come back, the instant petition for Habeas Corpus has rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
