Reply has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Surinder Mohan, PPS, Asstt. Commissioner of Police (Gill-Rural), Ludhiana. The same is taken on record.

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A perusal of the reply reveals that three different FIRs bearing No.71 dated 10.05.2016, FIR No.75 dated 10.05.2016 and FIR No.98 dated 04.06.2016, all under Sections 212 and 216 IPC, Police Station Sadar, Ludhiana were registered against the alleged detenues, namely, Rajinder Pal, Raju Pal and Sanju Pal respectively for giving shelter to the absconded accused of a serious crime.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
