The grievance of the petitioner is that his leave encashment and arrears of salary have not been released by the respondents so far. The petitioner was working in the Jawaharwala Rampura Multipurpose Cooperative Agricultural Service Society, District Sangrur.

On behalf of respondent No. 3, an objection has been raised regarding maintainability of the writ petition, stating that under Section 69 of the Punjab Co-operative Societies Act, 1961, the Registrar is competent to decide such matters suo motu.

In such circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Punjab, to decide the claim of the petitioner regarding his leave encashment and arrears of salary within two months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

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The copy of this order alongwith the copy of the petition be communicated to the Registrar Cooperative Societies, Punjab.
