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S.J. VAZIFDAR, A.C.J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents fairly states that an amount of Rs.94,000/- is the amount presently overdue in the account and that upon the payment thereof the account can be regularized.

2. The petitioner only seeks time till 15.06.2016 to pay the same. The future installments will be paid by the petitioner as per the agreement.

3. In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of by the following order:-

- i) Upon the petitioner paying an amount of Rs.94,000/- on or before 15.06.2016 the account shall be regularized. It is clarified that the sum of Rs.94,000/- includes interest on overdue amounts. In that event the petitioner shall continue to pay the future installments as per the agreement.

ii) In the event of the amount of Rs.94,000/- being paid by 15.06.2016, the impugned notice shall stand set-aside. Needless to add that in the event of there being any future defaults, the respondents are always entitled to issue fresh notices or take any other action in accordance with law.
