INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Article 226 of the constitution of India, for issuance of an appropriate and necessary direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the application dated 01.08.2015 (Annexure P-3), given to the Superintendent, District Jail, Sonapat, for releasing him prematurely as he has already undergone more than the requisite period of sentence of imprisonment as per Government Policy/Instructions dated 12.04.2002 (Annexure P-1), applicable at the time of conviction i.e. 01.04.2007 and decide the same at the earliest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said application (Annexure P-3) has been forwarded by Superintendent District Jail, Sonapat, to respondent Nos.1 and 2 and prays that the same be decided expeditiously.

Heard.

In view of above, respondent Nos.1 and 2 are directed to decide the said application dated 01.08.2015 (Annexure P-3), as per law expeditiously, preferably within two months after receiving the certified copy of this order.

With the aforesaid direction, the instant petition stands disposed of.
