This criminal writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Para 3(1) (d) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 and para 8(1) of the Haryana Government Gaz. (Extra), dated 18.12.2007 Rules for issuing writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 5 to grant parole to the petitioner for a period of four weeks has been filed by the petitioner – Sonia.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Kuldeep Tiwari, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5.

The main grievance of the petitioner in this petition is that she sent her application for seeking parole before Superintendent, District Jail, Yamuna Nagar (respondent No.5) dated 24.5.2016 (Annexure P-1)

for the admission of her children, but no action has been taken so far by the above-said respondents on her said application.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that ends of justice in this case will meet, if the petition be disposed of with the direction to respondents No.1 to 5 to deal with the representation (Annexure P-1) dated 24.5.2016 of the petitioner in accordance with law and to dispose of the same within two weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
