1. In this petition a transfer order dated June 13, 2013 has been challenged. No one has been appearing for the petitioner from December 18, 2014. Mr. Vaibhav Sharma points out that substantial justice has been done in the case of the petitioner after passing of the transfer order, whereby she has been held entitled to her salary from the date of the order and no adverse orders will be visited upon her because of any reason arising out of the impugned transfer order.

2. In view of above, no useful purpose will be served in keeping this petition pending to await counsel for the petitioner in a transfer matter when in the meantime the general transfers must have also taken place. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
