JASPAL SINGH, J

This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1) (b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 seeking release of the petitioner on emergency parole for six weeks to look after all the arrangements of marriage of his sister-Varsha, which is to be held on 11.02.2016 as well as for repair of his house in the village.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though an application seeking parole (Annexure P-2) was moved on December 03, 2015 to the Superintendent of Police, District Jail Gurgaon but till date no action has been taken.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. Tanuj Sharma, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Haryana. Copy of the

petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent District Jail, Gurgaon to look into the grievances of petitioner unfolded by him in his application dated 03.12.2015 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
