Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a roving writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondents to produce the detainee, namely, Rajwinder Kaur, who is in illegal custody of private respondents.

Mr. K.G. Chaudhry, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of alleged detainee, namely, Rajwinder Kaur, and filed power of attorney on her behalf which is taken on record. Rajwinder Kaur is also present in court.

Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Jaimal Singh, PPS, Dy. Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Valtaha Camp at Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran, in court today on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 which is taken on record. As per reply, the alleged

detainee-Rajwinder Kaur was never abducted/kidnapped by anyone. Rather

the petitioner and his family members have turned her out from the matrimonial home. It is under these compelling circumstances, she is staying with her parents i.e. respondents.

Affidavit of Rajwinder Kaur reiterating the above narration has also been filed, which is taken on record.

In view of above, the present petition seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus is misconceived and is dismissed as such.
