Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Manvir Singh Bajwa, PPS, D.S.P., Rupnagar, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, which is taken on record.

Relying upon the reply filed on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, learned State counsel submits that wife of the petitioner is not in the custody of the State of Punjab. He submits that on the basis of enquiry conducted by the Police Post Purkhali, District Rupnagar, it has been revealed that FIR No.69 dated 12.4.2016 under Sections 363, 366-A IPC was registered against the petitioner at Police Station Chandi Mandir, District Panchkula with the allegations that he had kidnapped the alleged detenue.

Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
