INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has preferred the instant criminal writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to release detainees namely Balwinder Singh, Harjit Singh and Sukhwinder Singh, who have been kept in illegal custody by C.I.A.Staff Jagroan since 04.07.2016 and they did not produce them in any competent Court of law till date.

In compliance of order dated 12.07.2016, passed by this Court, report of the Warrant Officer has been received.

As per the said report, Warrant Officer visited Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana at about 9:50 p.m. and found Balwinder Singh, Harjit Singh and Sukhwinder Singh (alleged detainees) in the lock-up room. On inquiry, ASI Jivan Singh informed that the said persons were arrested in case FIR No.116 dated 12.07.2016, registered at Police Station Sidhwan Bet, District Ludhiana, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and their arrest has been shown in DDR at Sr. No.26 on 12.07.2016 at 5:27 p.m. It is further informed that the abovesaid persons will be produced in the Court tomorrow i.e. 13.07.2016.

The Warrant Officer made his entry in the DDR at Sr. No.38 dated 12.07.2016 and he visited at 9:50 p.m.

Keeping in view the report of Warrant Officer, no further action is required in the instant petition.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands disposed of.
