On the basis of the representation submitted by Preetio Bai, addressed to the Hon'ble Chief Justice, the present criminal writ petition was registered.

It is the claim of the petitioner Preetio Bai that her daughter-in-law Seema Bai is in the illegal custody of accused Sarabjit Singh @ Sukha son of Tek Chand, resident of Panj Peer, Abohar.

Learned State counsel has filed the reply by way of affidavit of Shri Manvinder Bir Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib. Alongwith the reply, statement of petitioner Preetio Bai has been attached, which read as under :-

“Stated that I am the resident of above given

address and I do the labour work. My daughter-in-law Seema Bai w/o Kala singh left the house after quarrelling with her husband Kala Singh and went to her sisters Chhindo Rani and Rani at Sirsa. Earlier also, with the help of the police, we brought her back from Sirsa and again, Seema Bai has gone to her sisters at Sirsa and is living there and she has gone with her wishes. Statement got recorded, heard and found correct.”

As per statement of Preetoi Bai, her daughter-in-law Seema Bai has left the house after quarrelling with her husband Kala singh and went to her sisters Chhindo Rani and Rani at Sirsa. She has stated that Seema Bai has gone to her sisters with her own wishes.

In view of the reply filed by the State, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition.
