AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Article 226 for grant of agriculture parole for six weeks. The same was declined by the Divisional Commissioner, Rohtak.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has argued that on the last occasion when the petitioner was released on parole he committed a murder and earlier when parole was granted there was six days over stay.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said incident happened six years ago and has relied upon the judgments passed by this Court in ***Ranjit Singh Vs. Union Territory Administration, Chandigarh and another, RCR 1989 (2), 161*** and ***Jagdish Vs. State of Haryana and others, 2016 (2) RCR (Criminal), 641.***

In view of the above judgments and the fact that the District Magistrate Sonapat has recommended that his prayer be granted, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the same and further allow him parole for six weeks.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
