The learned State counsel on instructions states that neither there is any FIR against the petitioner nor is he required for any other purpose by the State. He was never picked up. Even during the visit of the Warrant Officer, he was not found at the designated place. As per the information collected by the Police the alleged detenu is residing with his family members.

In view of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

However, in case the statement made by the learned counsel for the

State that the detenu has joined his family is found to be against the record, the petitioner shall be at liberty to revive the present petition.
