Prayer in this petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus or roving writ to secure the release of Parminder Kaur, alleged detenue, who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6 since 12.07.2016.

Pursuant to the order dated 15.07.2016 passed by this Court, the alleged detenue, namely, Parminder Kaur is present in Court.

Mr. Simran Jit Singh, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.4 to 6 and filed vakalatnama which is taken on record. He states that the alleged detenue was never in illegal custody. The

girl, who is present in court, also submits that she is not in illegal custody of the respondents No.4 to 6. The girl (alleged detenue) is identified by I.O. ASI Prithvi Raj Singh.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press this petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
