A complaint was received in the office of Chief Justice's Secretariat which has been treated as Criminal Writ Petition.

On perusal of the complaint/petition, Warrant Officer was appointed with a direction to find out the detenu. After the compliance of necessary direction, Warrant Officer has submitted his report dated July 26, 2016 and the conclusion of the report reads as under:-

“I asked the Officer, why he had detained Sh. Simranjit Singh w.e.f. 05.07.2016. He denied the allegations made by petitioner and stated that Sh. Simranjit Singh, was arrested by City Police in the first week of July-2016 as he was required in so many cases (U/S 307/336/148/149, arms act 25/27, 21 NDPS act. registered in various Police Stations in Amritsar Annexure “A”, “A-I”, “B” & “C”) and he was declared as proclaimed offender on 15.02.2016 (Annexure “D”) by the Hon'ble Court and so many cases are pending against Sh. Simranjit Singh in other Various Police Stations of Amritsar.

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A glance at the aforesaid report transpires that large number of criminal cases have been registered against the alleged detenu in different police stations and in some of the cases he has been declared as proclaimed offender. The report further reveals that in view of the aforesaid facts, he was arrested in the first week of July, 2016. It appears that instant petition has been moved with malafide intention by alleging his illegal detention just to save his skin from the consequences of the various cases registered against him.

In view of above, instant petition has rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.
