By filing the present petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks directions to the respondents for his release on parole for a period of three weeks on account of illness of his mother who has to undergo surgery for acute cholecystitis with cholelithiasis.

It is contended that the mother of the petitioner is seriously ill and she has to undergo surgery. There is nobody in the family to look after her.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel opposes the prayer made.

Heard.

On the last date of hearing, a hand written document of

Pinkcity Heart & General Hospital was placed on record. However, this Court was not satisfied with the authenticity of the document. Today also, the document produced from the hospital does not inspire the Court's conscience with regard to authenticity of the document. Otherwise also, there is nothing on record to show the composition of the petitioner's family which would suggest that the petitioner is the only member to take care of her mother. Keeping in view the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the present petition.

Dismissed.
