Petitioner-Baljinder Singh son of Surjit Singh, resident of Ward No.27, Village Khanna Khurd, Tehsil Khanna, District Ludhiana, has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ, order or directions especially in the nature of Habeas Corpus with roving writ with the prayer for appointing a Warrant Officer from this Hon'ble High Court with direction to search the detenues named Paramjit Kaur and Harpreet Kaur who are in illegal custody of respondent No.3 or his staff.

Paramjit Kaur and Harpreet Kaur are mother and wife of the petitioner respectively. They were picked up by the police on 22.07.2016 from their house.

On 23.07.2016, while issuing notice of motion a Warrant Officer was appointed to visit the place as pointed out by the petitioner to locate the said detenues and submit a report in this regard.

As per report submitted by Warrant Officer, the alleged detainee were not found either detained or otherwise in the premises of police stations.

Learned counsel for the State submits that a case FIR No.74, dated 11.06.2016, Police Station Amloh, stands registered against the alleged detainee.

In view of above, the present petition no more survives and accordingly dismissed.
